Distance Healing from the Casa de Dom Inácio

Sending Photographs for Herbs/Surrogate Surgery

If you are unable to travel to Abadiânia to visit the Casa de Dom Inácio in person, it is possible to send photographs with Peter Waugh.

The photographs are shown to the Entity who scans them and writes out a prescription for herbs which will address the issues currently facing the individual. Each person receives the same kind of herbs (labeled “Passiflora”), however, each bottle is specifically energised by the Entity to meet the needs of the person in the photographs.

If the Entity marks an “X” on the photograph, it means that the person requires spiritual surgery, either in person or through a surrogate. If possible, it is advisable to travel to Brazil or attend one of the international events for this purpose.

Taking Herbs

It is very important that you do not share your herbs with anyone else as they are specifically energised for each person.

There is a dietary restriction notice that accompanies the herbs: no alcohol, no pig meats, no chillies or hot spicy food.

Please do not arrange to send any photographs for review unless there is a firm commitment to follow the dietary restriction and to take the herbs. Please explain these restrictions if you are arranging for family or friends to send photographs. Please refer to the “Instructions for Taking Herbs” sheet for further details.

Surrogate Surgery

If you receive an “X” on your photographs and are unable to travel to Brazil in the near future, it is possible to have surrogate surgery. If the Entities give permission, Peter can sit in the surgery room in Brazil and act as a conduit to the person receiving the surgery. The recipient must be in bed at the time and follow the protocol detailed in the “Post Surrogate Surgery” sheet.

Fee for Taking Photographs to Brazil

The fee is NZ \$120 (incl GST) – cash is preferred so that it can be easily converted to USD.

The fee covers the cost of the herbs, admin, postage and handling. Any surplus is given to the soup kitchen in Abadiânia, or used to support future tours and associated work.

How to Take Photographs

Either arrange a time for the photographs to be taken by Peter at the Natural Health Centre or take them yourself as detailed below:

Please take three photographs of each person, fully clothed and against a light colored background. All photographs must be portrait, not landscape.

1. **Frontal view:** photograph is to be taken from the thighs up and as close as possible to obtain a clear full frontal image of the face and torso.
2. **Side view:** photograph is a full-length body photo from head to toe of the left (heart) side of the body.
3. **Back view:** photograph is a full-length body photo from head to toe of the back of the body.

Record name, date of birth and address on the back of the photographs. Complete the form below for each person. If emailing photographs, use jpeg format and include your details in the email message.
